

**Highlights: Wine Tasting at PB Valley / Ban Mai Chai Nam/ Chok Chai Farm Tour/ Primo Piazza / Palio Shopping Complex/ Khao Yai National Park**

**Day 1: Bangkok – Khaoyai (Sunflower Field/PB Valley Winery Tour/ Primo Piazza/ Midwinter Green)**

AM: Pick up from hotel or airport in Bangkok. Depart for Saraburi where you can enjoy taking pictures of Sun Flower Fields

Visit **Sun flower field in Saraburi** (Blooming season is from end of November to February, I will inform you if any sunflower field during your travel period) In case off season, we suggest you to visit other attraction in Khao Yai.

Lunch at a local restaurant (own expense)



Visit **PB Valley** for wine tasting tour for 75 minutes, a glass of wine is included.

*PB Valley will give you a guided winery tour to see the vineyard at 380 meters above the sea level and wine production site surrounded by mountainous setting. You will be enlightened about wine from harvest to restaurant. Moreover, wine tasting is also included in a tour. It is a good chance for you to taste 3 Thai wines namely PB Khao Yai Reserve Chenin Blanc, PB Khao Yai Rose and PB Khao Yai Reserve Shiraz. Even its taste is not comparable to wine from European counties but it is surprisingly good for wine made in Asia. End up your trip with some delicious fusion dishes at The Great Hornbill Grill, a country-style restaurant catering both Western and Thai cuisine. Tasty food and good wines are the best combination that will brighten up your day.*

PM: **Visit Primo Piazza:** Another attraction not to be missed in Khao Yai 'Primo Piazza' was built and inspired by Tuscany region, Italy. You can enjoy taking pictures, feeding sheep, donkey, and alpaca, relaxing at café and restaurants.

AM: **Visit The Hobbit House**, take a picture and dress up like a movie scene.

## Day 4: Khaoyai – Bangkok (Farm Chock chai)

AM: Check out

**Visit Farm Chokchai**, is a birthplace of abundant agro-tourism with superb atmosphere. It is the Thailand's largest dairy farm with a long history. Enjoy the farm tour for 2 hours, a tractor will take you around to see what is inside the farm, machinery museum, milking parlor, cowboy and pet show
